1. MINUTES

The minutes of the previous meeting (28^ú Feabhra 2012) were passed as a fair and accurate reflection of the meeting.

2. AON GHNÓ EILE

Several items were nominated for AOB.

3. EDUCATION OFFICER UPDATE

The Education Officer gave an update on plans for An Seisiún Mór. He highlighted difficulties with attracting international acts as a result of international festivals that were being held in March.

4. SEACHTAIN NA GAEILGE

An tOifigeach na Gaeilge was not present to give an update on Seachtain na Gaeilge activities, however it was noted that all events to date seem to have been very successful. The Committee extended congratulations to An tOifigeach na Gaeilge for the success of Seachtain na Gaeilge.

5. MENTAL HEALTH DAY

The Welfare Officer noted that he planned to organise a Mental Health Day as a follow up to Mental Health Week. Further plans will be shared when available.

6. ELECTIONS WEEK

The Education Officer noted that he had received various complaints from candidates. He noted that only two candidates had not made complaints or had complaints made against them.

The issue of an email being sent to all students in the English Department is being investigated.

It was highlighted that FEE was endorsing candidates and a discussion ensued regarding the endorsement of candidates' campaigns.

It was noted that the Elections Committee would issue stern warnings to candidates who are allegedly operating on the margins of the election regulations.

7. AON GHNÓ EILE

Activist Academy

The SU Council Chairperson noted that the recent Activist Academy was a success. However, she expressed disappointment that only three members of the Executive Committee were present.

The Committee extended congratulations to the SU Council Chairperson on the success of the event.

Love Music Hate Racism

The SU Council Chairperson noted that the director of Love Music Hate Racism participated in the recent Activist Academy. In the course of discussions with him, he noted that there has been no collaboration between Love Music Hate Racism and the Students' Union on any events earlier in the academic year. He added that no permission had been given to use the Love Music Hate Racism logo on any promotional material for any music events.

Fees March

It was noted that the recent Fees March deviated from the agreed march route and concluded with an occupation of a branch of an AIB Bank.

It was also noted that the Students' Union were wrongly associated with the attempted occupation which was unacceptable.

Following a brief discussion it was proposed that the Students' Union would not collaborate with FEE on any activities in future.

A vote was called, and the proposal was agreed unanimously.
